UNIT 4 FOCUS

In Unit 3, we took a deep dive into the Gospel and why we needed Jesus to come and be our Savior. To follow that, Unit 4 will be all about discipleship and what living a Christian life is all about. How do you grow in your walk with Christ and follow Him every day?

We will learn about putting our faith in Jesus and believing in His salvation for our own sin, the importance of prayer: both talking to and listening to God. We will learn the importance of reading and studying the Bible for ourselves and how God uses the Bible to teach us, correct us, and give us wisdom. Worship of God takes different forms, sometimes it involves singing but it also comes in other forms. Worship is anything we do to show God that we love Him and He is important to us. Serving like Jesus served, putting others before yourself, is not always easy, but Jesus showed us how to live the life as one who serves others well. In Unit 4 we will also learn about having right fellowship with other people. Our life should be a witness and give evidence of our salvation and relationship with Jesus by the things we say and the way we live, so that others can see the truth and trust in Christ.
